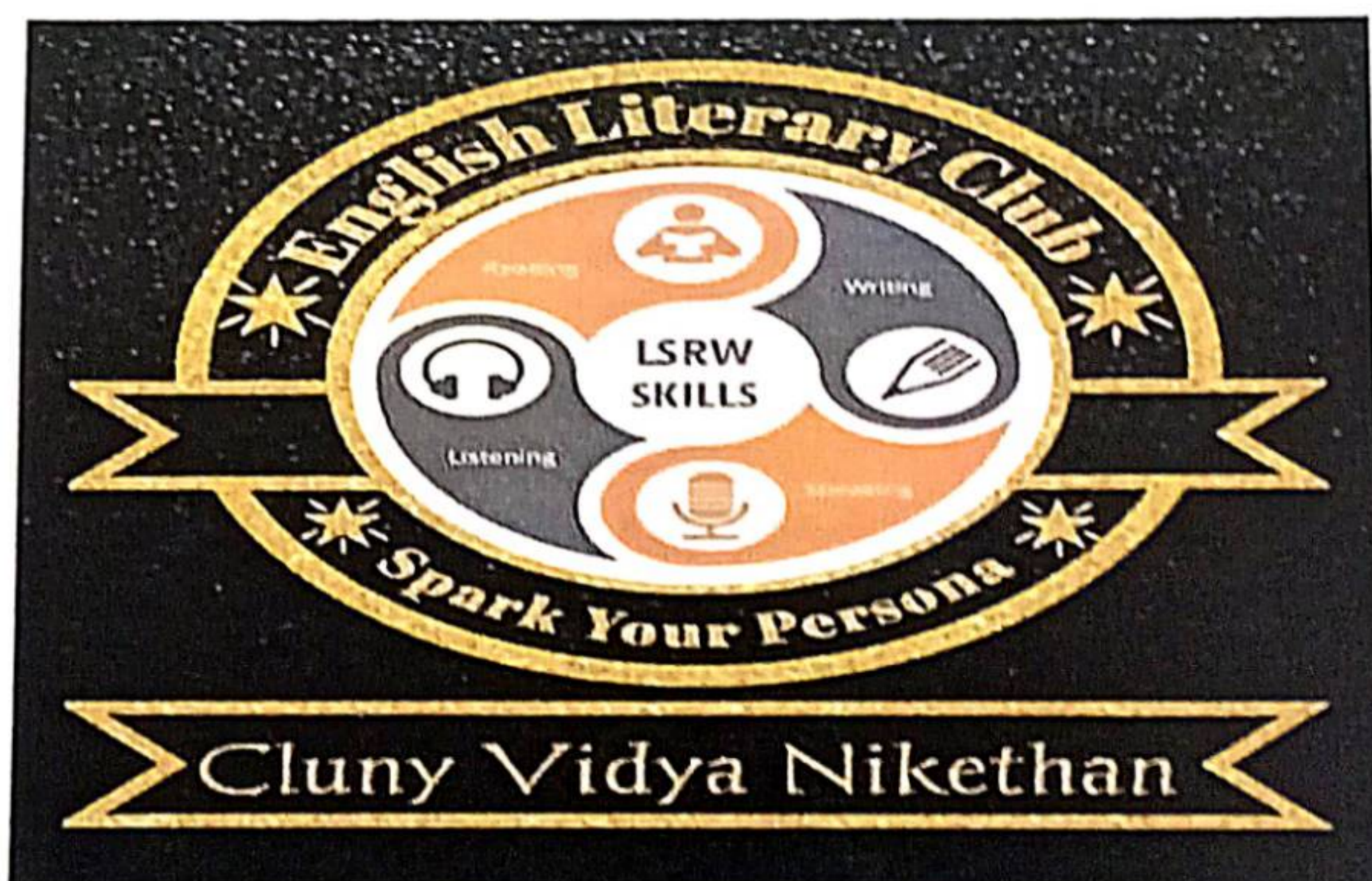

### **ENGLISH LITERARY CLUB**

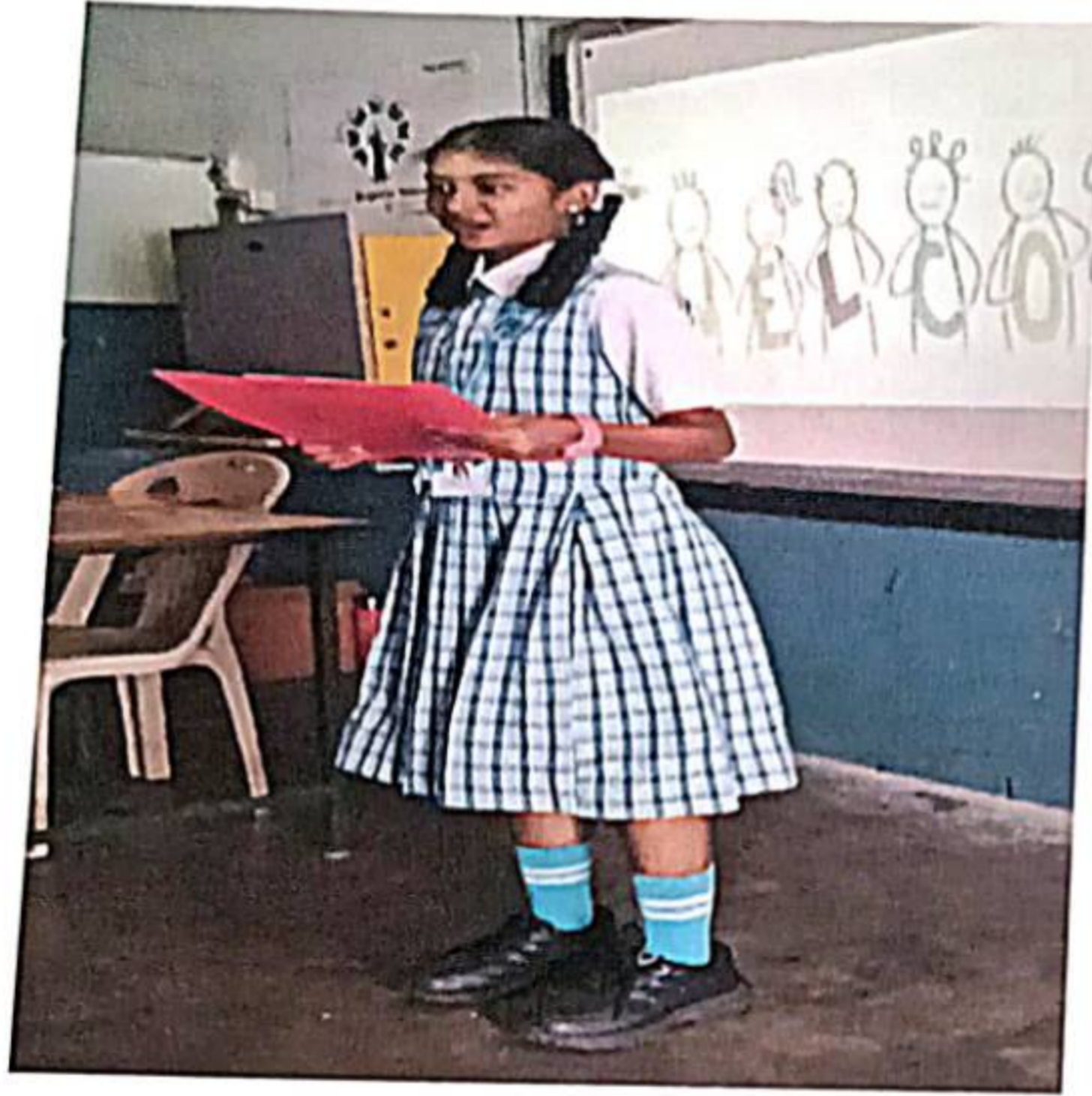


The Club actively engaged in different icebreaker activities. After energizers the activities to be conducted are listed using Power Point presentation.

The activities include:





**Grade 7:** *Word Hunt* – a thrilling contest that tested vocabulary and quick thinking.

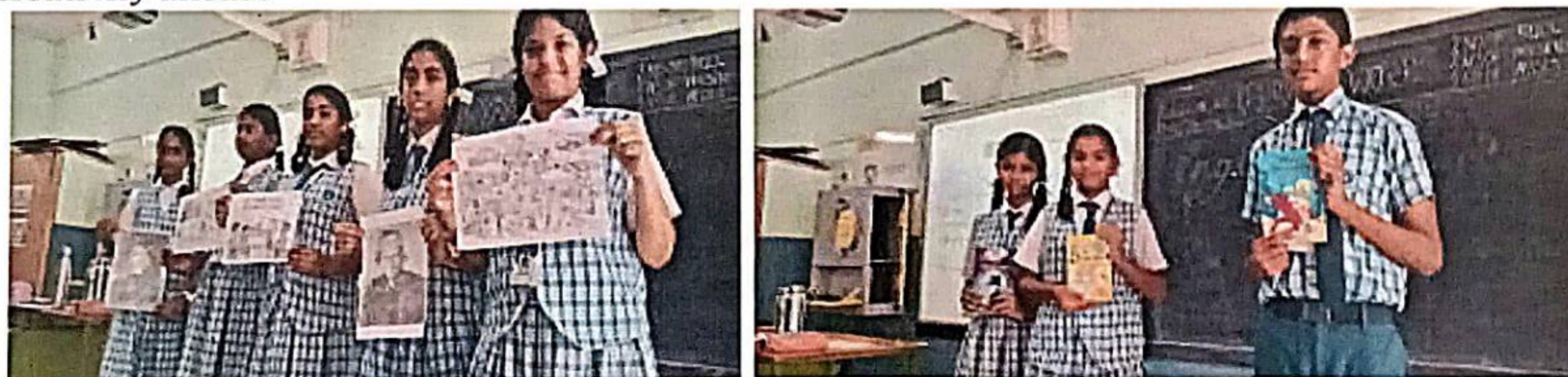
**Grade 8:** *Speech on "The Best Day of My Life"* – where students shared heartfelt experiences with confidence and clarity.

**Grade 8:** Book Review – where readers became critics, giving voices to the pages they loved.

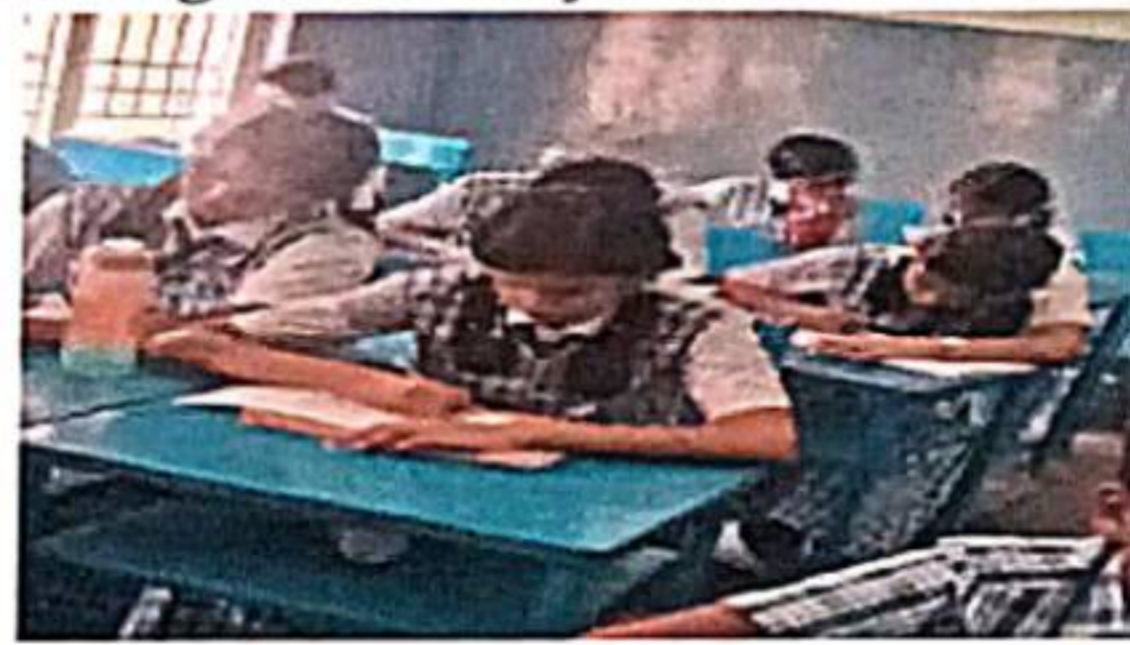
**Grade 9:** Picture Talk – a canvas of imagination painted with words and perception.
