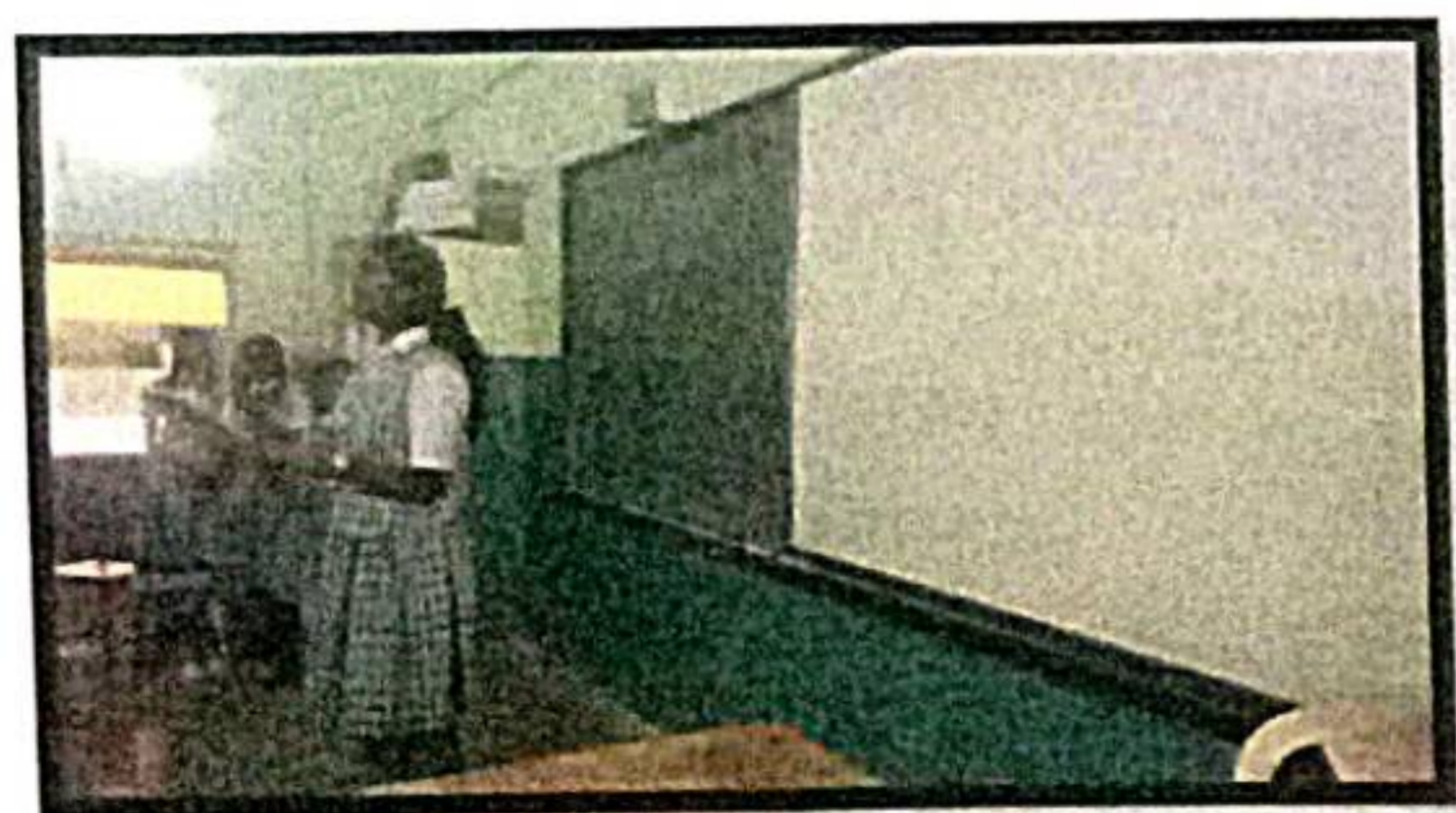
As a prelude to its formal calendar of events, an unofficial club meeting was convened on 20th June 2025 under the distinguished guidance of Principal

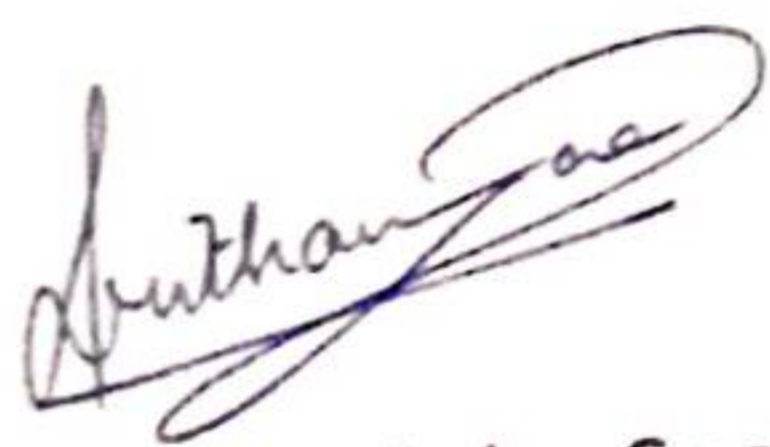

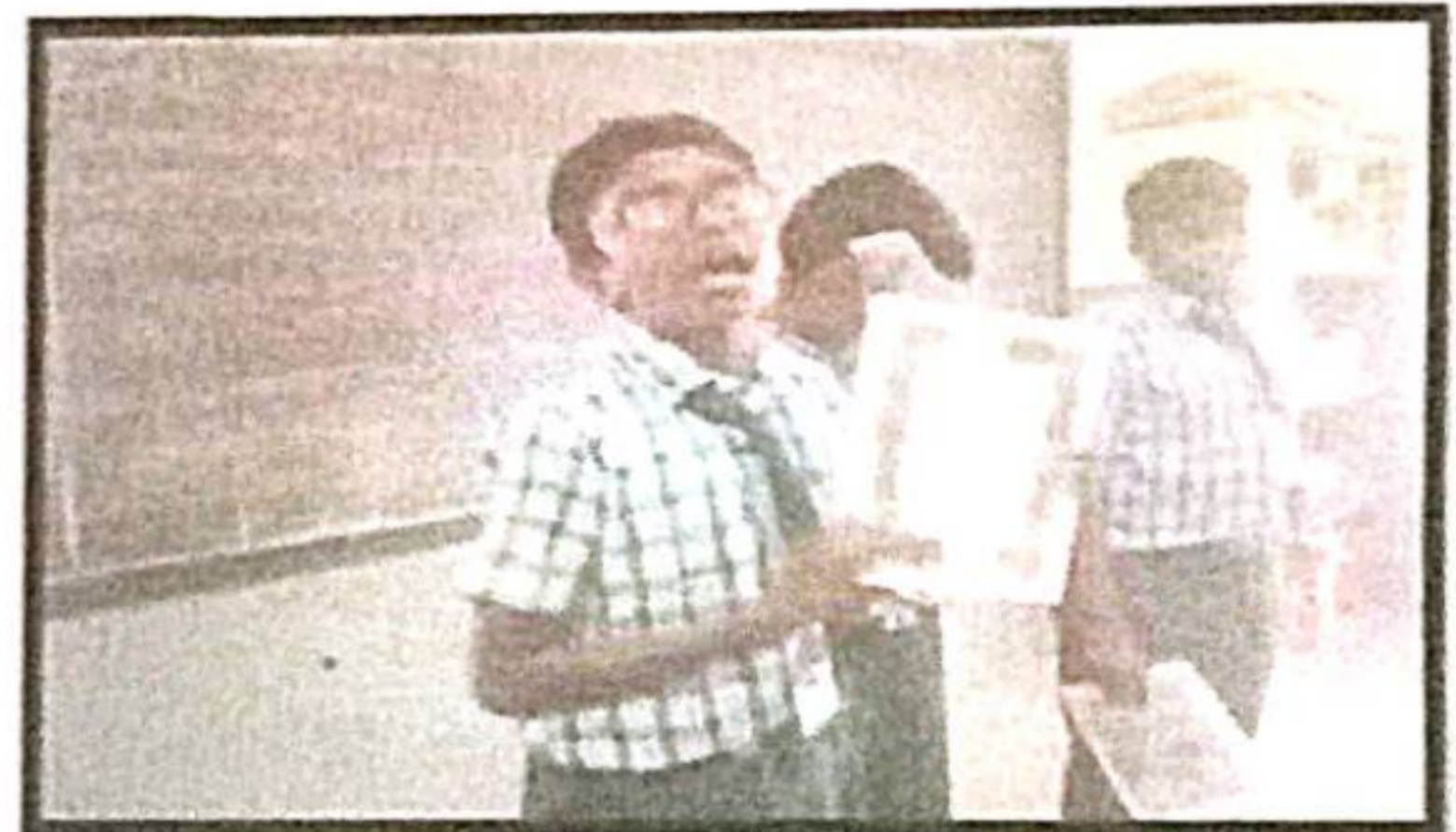
Second Meet – July 2025

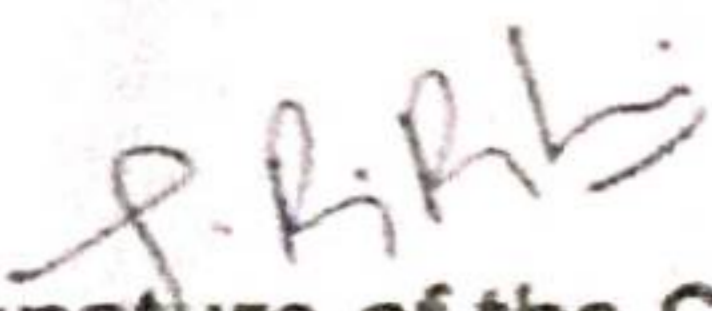

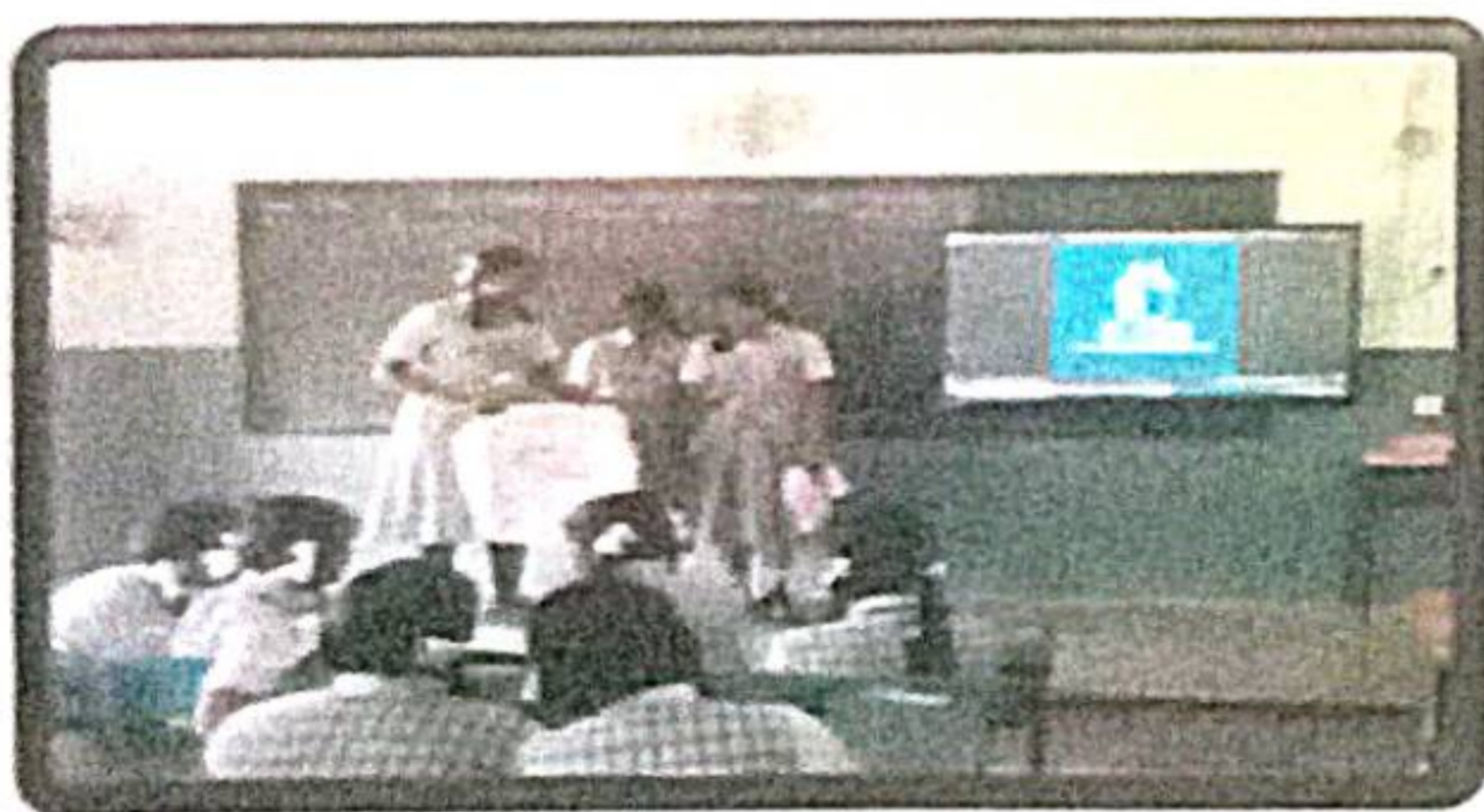
Third Meet – August 2025
